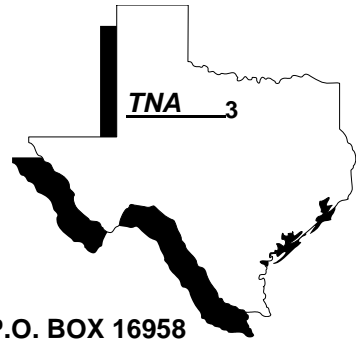

The 80th Texas Legislature has come to a close and though it is 115 degrees outside, autumn is just around the corner. Does this mean the TNA can take a much needed rest? The answer to that million dollar question is NO!

The TNA is already preparing for the 2008 Primaries and Elections. As nurses you will soon need to decide if you are voting for the party, candidate or the issues and as always healthcare will be a key in all platforms.

The TNA strongly encourages you to become familiar with the candidates and their issues. Go on-line and look at their voting history. Is the candidate nurse friendly? How do they feel about health care? How do they vote on policies regarding coverage for citizens; especially, children and the elderly? Just some thoughts to ponder.

All programs and legislation have a trickle down effect so if you think it does not affect your specific job you could be wrong. Now is the time to get involved while you can still make a difference to nursing and health care.

The TNA is putting a call out to members who are interested in governmental affairs and want to be involved in the political process for nursing issues. Also the Annotated Nurse Practice Act will be available beginning September 1, 2007. Among the changes to the NPA are changes to Peer Review and Safe Harbor. The Annotated Nurse Practice Act will give you the details. All nurses should review the NPA so their practice continues to be maintained within the law.

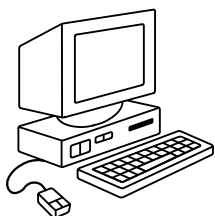

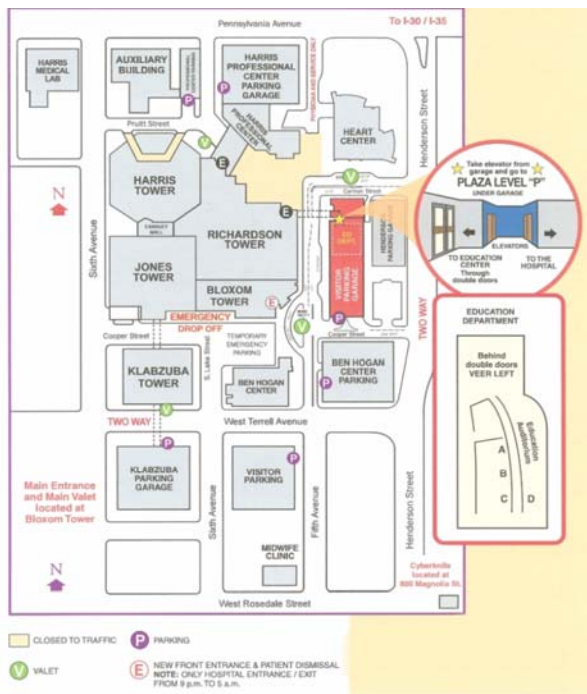

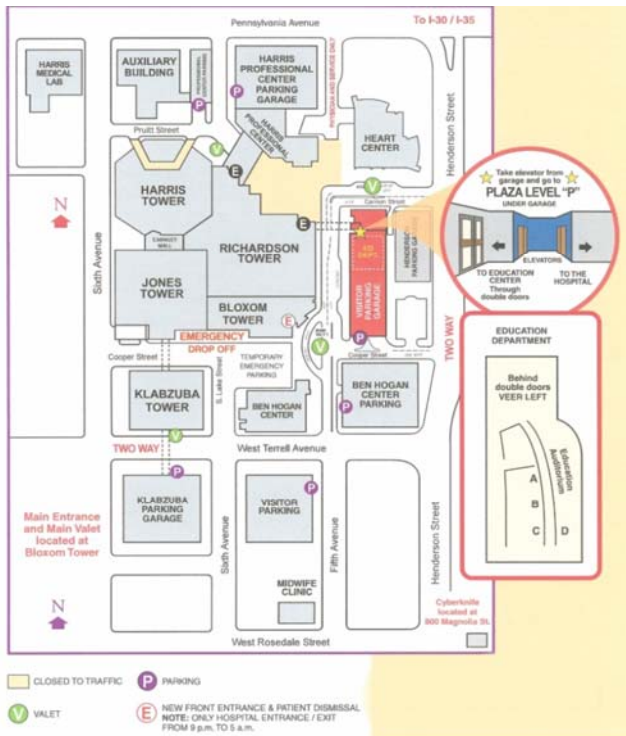

2. Attach a **one page** letter of recommendation which provides supportive documentation about your nominee. Resumes and curriculum vitae will **not** be accepted. **Letters must be submitted on 8 1/2 X 11 paper, no letterhead, and one-sided printing. Letters which do not conform to this criteria will be disqualified.** The nomination letter **should not include the nominee's name nor specific identification about the Registered Nurse (e.g., place of employment).** The letter of recommendation must address each of the following categories:

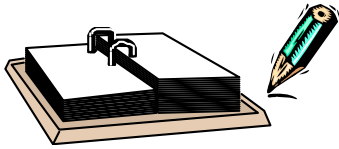
